## Right at the beginning Initial reach-out and meet-up

Hold a coffee/lunch or other "get-to-know-you" meet-up with the newcomer(s). Suggest "first steps" to the new parishioner(s) based on thei interests, desires and call.

2 A month or two into it Accompany to New Parishioner Mass

Determine which monthly NPM to attend and accompany the new parishioner(s) to the Mass.

1-3 months into it

and accompany them there.

Throughout the 6 months
Ongoing support & hospitality

Answer questions, issue invitations, and provde additional support as needed.

Check how things are going, determine unmet needs, and connect newcomers(s) to any additional resources, programs or people.
